Dear Sir or Madam,

My name is Gert Gustedt and I live in Kirkland, Washington. Please contact me at this email address for any responses.

I have become aware of this opportunity to comment on the DOH and OSPI evaluation of safety of Wi-Fi in schools and would like to share my concerns as I have a lovely 4.5 year old daughter who is going to attend Kindergarten later this year. I'm a citizen that is very interested in health. I hold a master's degree in Applied Behavioral Science since 2004 and follow the latest discoveries in the mental health as well as medical fields regularly. I attend medical conferences in the area such as conferences by Dr. Klinghardt, MD, PhD and the monthly lectures at the Functional Medicine Meeting in Bellevue, WA (organized by Dr. Musnick, MD) and other conferences. I have taken multi-day classes on how to detect, measure and ameliorate electro-magnetic and microwave radiation fields in order to minimize their affect on humans. Based on several teachers, lecturers and medical expert opinions who have reviewed domestic and especially international long-term studies (beyond 5 years) related to the exposure of populations to microwave radiation and its effects on the health of those populations and have seen the health effects of microwave radiation directly in their patients, it appears that on the biological level normal cell functions are measurably being disrupted by wi-fi and other microwave radiation with long term consequences showing up as a statistically significant increase in illnesses (mental such as ADHD/ADD and physical such as tumors, etc.). Logic tells me that if the growing brains and bodies of children are exposed long-term to microwave radiation in schools that their health is at a much higher risk than those of adults as their bodies are more vulnerable because they still undergo a much higher rate of cell division due to the growing process and therefore the chances of things going wrong biologically in our children is even greater. Why are there so many children with cancer? I believe the environment we create plays a role in this problem.

I don't believe we have a right to knowingly gamble with the health of our children, our future, who do not even have a voice in this process. There are vested interests that try to suppress negative information related to wi-fi in schools or in general. We potentially pay with a decrease in intelligence, increased degenerative illnesses, related grief and pain and rising health care costs that are already bringing this country to its knees. If we don't have our health, we don't have anything. The future of our country depends on ensuring our children's health and nurturing the development of a healthy intelligent population via a healthy environment. Please ban wi-fi from schools and continue to implement cabled internet access in schools to significantly decrease the risk of illness due to wireless radiation.
