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**Subject:** Public comment-wi-fi in schools  
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I would like to comment on the DOH/OSPI conclusion that “WI-FI is unlikely to pose a health risk”. Upon attending seminars in which professionals cited studies in which the opposite conclusion was formulated, I believe that the DOH/OSPI conclusion is inaccurate and is based on:

- a suppression of evidence (2013 French report, 2013 BCCDC report and 2009 U.S. DHHS report);
- dilution of the evidence with biased and obsolete reports;
- **and Is in direct opposition** to the most recent findings of international health organizations (WHO; 2013 French report, 2013 BCCDC and 2009 U.S. DHHS reports).

As this study is affecting the health of many of our children and grandchildren now and in the future, I urge you to look at this issue more thoroughly.

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
