Dear Senator Keiser:

I am writing as chair of the Washington State Board of Health to support Senate Bill 5930, which is scheduled to be heard before your committee this afternoon. This bill would implement many of the recommendations of the Blue Ribbon Commission on Health Care Costs and Access.

While many elements of this bill are commendable from a public health perspective, such as the emphasis on health promotion and prevention, I would like to speak specifically to section 19. This would provide additional noncategorical state funding to local health jurisdictions. That funding would be dispersed through contracts that would be tied to performance standards and data reporting. The Board is keenly aware of the funding difficulties facing the public health system in Washington State. It also believes that performance standards are necessary. Only through such standards can accountability be achieved.

Thank you for taking up this critically important issue.
