



NEWBORN SCREENING PROGRAM CURRENT SCREENING PANEL—JANUARY 2008

Chapter 246-650 WAC requires screening for the preventable disorders listed below:

Biotinidase deficiency

Congenital adrenal hyperplasia (CAH)

Congenital hypothyroidism

Cystic Fibrosis (CF)

Galactosemia

Homocystinuria

Maple Syrup Urine Disease (MSUD)

Medium chain acyl CoA dehydrogenase (MCAD) deficiency

Phenylketonuria (PKU)

Hemoglobinopathies, including sickle cell disease (the national recommendations count three conditions among these: sickle cell anemia, sickle – C disease, and sickle – beta thalassemia)

Although not required by the regulations, all hospitals in Washington now screen infants for hearing loss before they are discharged.
