**Department of Health**

- Develop technical materials and make training available
- Triennial report to SBOH on variances and implementation
- Quadrennial update of K-12 Health and Safety Guide



**Local Health Officers**

- Annual school inspections – self inspections allowed 2 out of 3 yrs
- Annual report to DOH on variances granted



**School Officials**

- Annual environmental health and safety report to school board
- HVAC duct lining and ducted air returns building plan approval
- Drinking water monitoring - lead
  - Elementary 50%
  - Elementary completed
  - Middle and junior high
  - High school
- Drinking water monitoring - copper
  - Elementary
  - Middle and junior high
  - High school
