

## Correction to the Nutrition Risk Changes Phase 2 Training

Note the following correction in Part 2 of the [video](#) and page 19 of the [Participant Copy](#). We stated the underweight woman pregnant with multiples would be assigned the risk of high weight gain when the woman's weight plots above the top line. This would have made her high risk.

### **Correction for underweight woman with multiples:**

Client Services won't assign High Weight Gain 1<sup>st</sup> Trimester or High Weight Gain 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Trimester when the underweight woman's weight plots above the top line of the recommended weight gain range. This woman isn't flagged as high risk because she doesn't have a high weight gain risk assigned.

Even though she isn't high risk, it is best practice to schedule the underweight woman pregnant with multiples to see the nutritionist. The CPA designates her as Professional Discretion High Risk.

### **Additional information:**

The Institute of Medicine didn't provide weight gain recommendations for underweight women pregnant with multiples. Without data, we could not create a specific grid for these clients. We decided to not have Client Services calculate and assign the high weight gain risks for these women.
