



# Is your child in danger from a recalled product?

Each year, more than 60,000 children in the U.S. are treated in emergency rooms for injuries caused by recalled products.

Many recalled items are found at thrift stores, garage and yard sales, or are passed on from family members or friends. Before buying or using a second-hand product, check to be sure it is still safe and has not been recalled.
