



## EIP Dental

Beginning 7/1/08, the Early Intervention Program (EIP) will pay for dental services provided to EIP clients living within King County. Since 1/1/08 we have been paying for dental services to clients who live outside of King County.

### **Am I eligible?**

You are eligible if you:

- Have EIP eligibility (excluding temporary eligibility).
- Do not have dental insurance or other dental coverage such as Medicaid.

### **What do I need to know about EIP dental?**

- EIP pays for a broad range of basic services, but does not pay for all dental services. Our website has a list of these services. - You must go to a dentist who contracts with EIP. You can find the list of contracted dentists at [http://www.doh.wa.gov/cfh/hiv\\_aids/client\\_svcs/documents/Dent0508.pdf](http://www.doh.wa.gov/cfh/hiv_aids/client_svcs/documents/Dent0508.pdf).
- EIP can pay up to \$2500 per person per calendar year.

### **What dentist can I go to?**

- Your current dentist **only if** he/she contracts with EIP.
- Any dentist on EIP's list of contracted providers who is accepting new clients.

Call EIP or a local case management agency or AIDS Care Access Project (ACAP) to get the names of contracted dentists in your area.
