Meeting Purpose: Gain community, public health, and other perspectives on possible changes to state rules designed to:

1. Increase the proportion of HIV-infected persons who know their HIV status.
2. Increase the proportion of persons exposed to HIV who are informed of that exposure.
3. Align with CDC recommendations to routinely offer HIV diagnostic testing to everyone, ages 13-64, in all healthcare settings.
4. Ensure that timely and effective partner notification services are provided to all persons newly diagnosed with HIV.

Rules considered in this review include:

- WAC 246-100-011 – Communicable disease definitions.
- WAC 246-100-072 -- Rules for notification of partners at risk of HIV infection.
- WAC 246-100-207 – Human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) testing – Ordering – Laboratory screening – Interpretation – Reporting.
- WAC 246-100-208 – Counseling standards – AIDS counseling.
- WAC 249-100-209 – Counseling standards -- Human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) pretest counseling – HIV post-test counseling.
