An operator who's responsible for the daily operational activities of three or more public water systems.

***What is required to be a contract operator?***

- At a minimum, be certified as a WDM and CCS;
- Be available on a 24-hour basis (cell phone, answering machine, and so on).
- Send a copy of each operations contract to the Waterworks Operator Certification Program within 30 days of the effective date.
