BLOOD STOOL TEST [FOBT]	RESPONDENTS, AGE 50 AND OLDER, WHO REPORT THEY DID NOT HAVE A BLOOD STOOL TEST WITHIN THE PAST TWO YEARS.
CHOLESTEROL HIGH	RESPONDENTS WHO REPORT THEY HAVE HAD THEIR BLOOD CHOLESTEROL CHECKED AND WERE TOLD IT WAS HIGH BY DOCTOR, NURSE, OR OTHER HEALTH PROFESSIONAL.
