## What's New

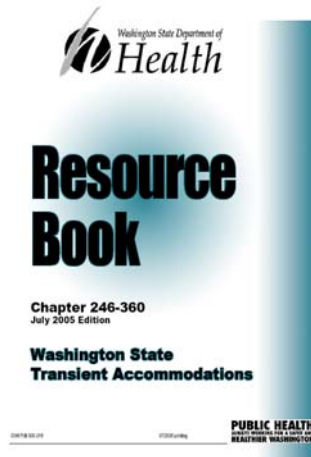
### New Manager:
