Renewal Card Process Changes

You'll notice changes in the license application process; we're using a 'Renewal Card' instead of the application form of previous years. We hope you find this more convenient. Please send us any comments you wish to share about the Renewal Card process.

Assisted Survey Pilot Program

This season we are piloting a modified self-survey program that consists of operators conducting their own pre-occupancy inspection followed by an occupancy inspection conducted by Program staff. Operators that qualified for the pilot will find instructions enclosed on how to proceed. If you weren't selected and would like to be considered for next year. Water Testing Schedule and Other Due Dates

Please remember that your schedule for submitting your 'application packet' has been split into specific timeframes based on your "down time" and 'primary occupancy' (when people start to arrive for the harvest).

UBI and Industrial Insurance

Please be aware that your UBI number and Industrial Insurance Account ID are required for our records (if applicable). Although this hasn't been monitored in the past, it will be required this season and on. Also, both UBI & Industrial Insurance ID are required to qualify for Self-Survey and Assisted-Survey Programs.
