Certificate of Need #1352 issued on August 3, 2007 approved a capital expenditure of \$4,934,998. This amended certificate approves the increase in capital costs of the project to transfer 38 dialysis stations from the Haviland Kidney Center, becoming a 15 station facility, to create a new 38 station dialysis facility named the Seattle Kidney Center.
