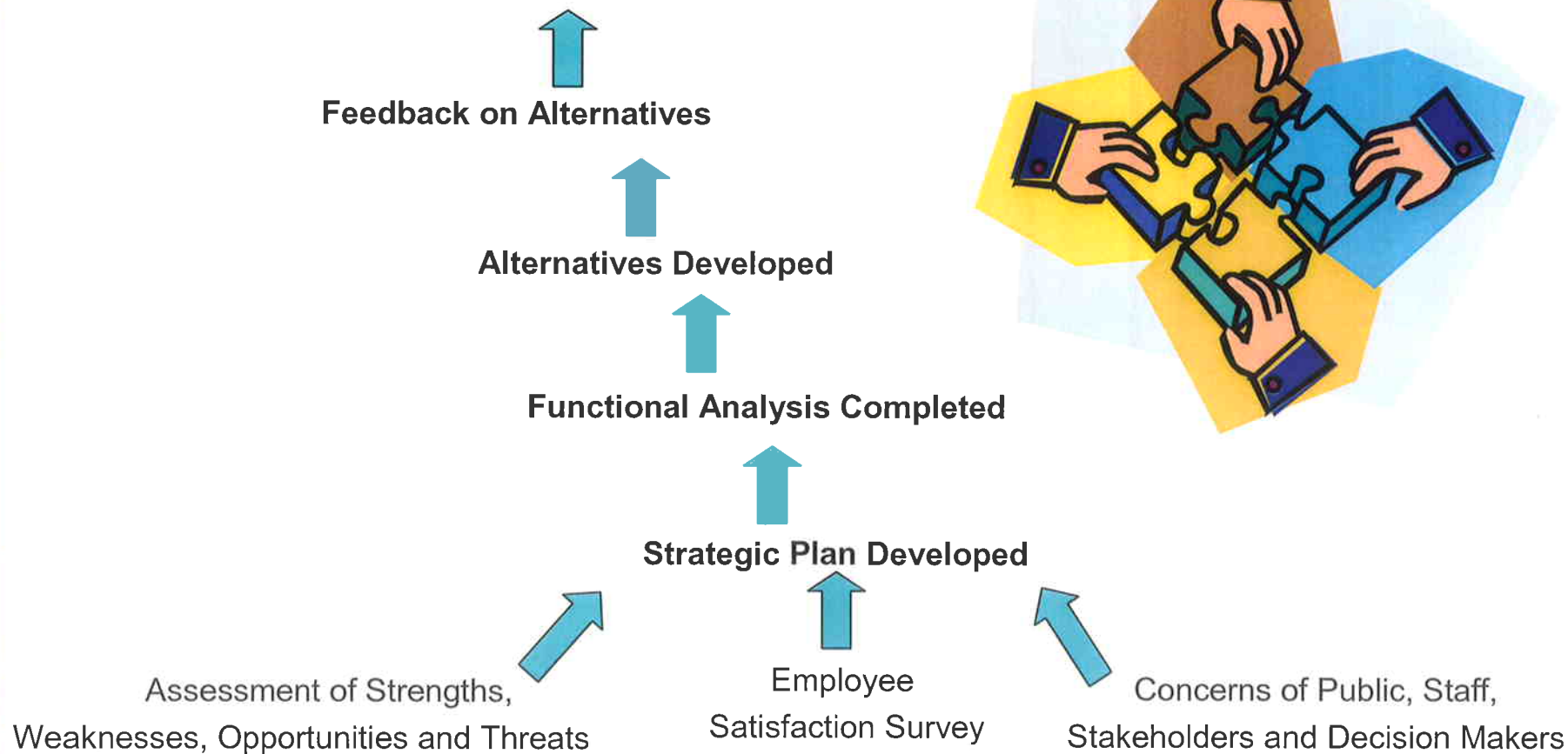

- *Improving workforce diversity, competency and satisfaction.*

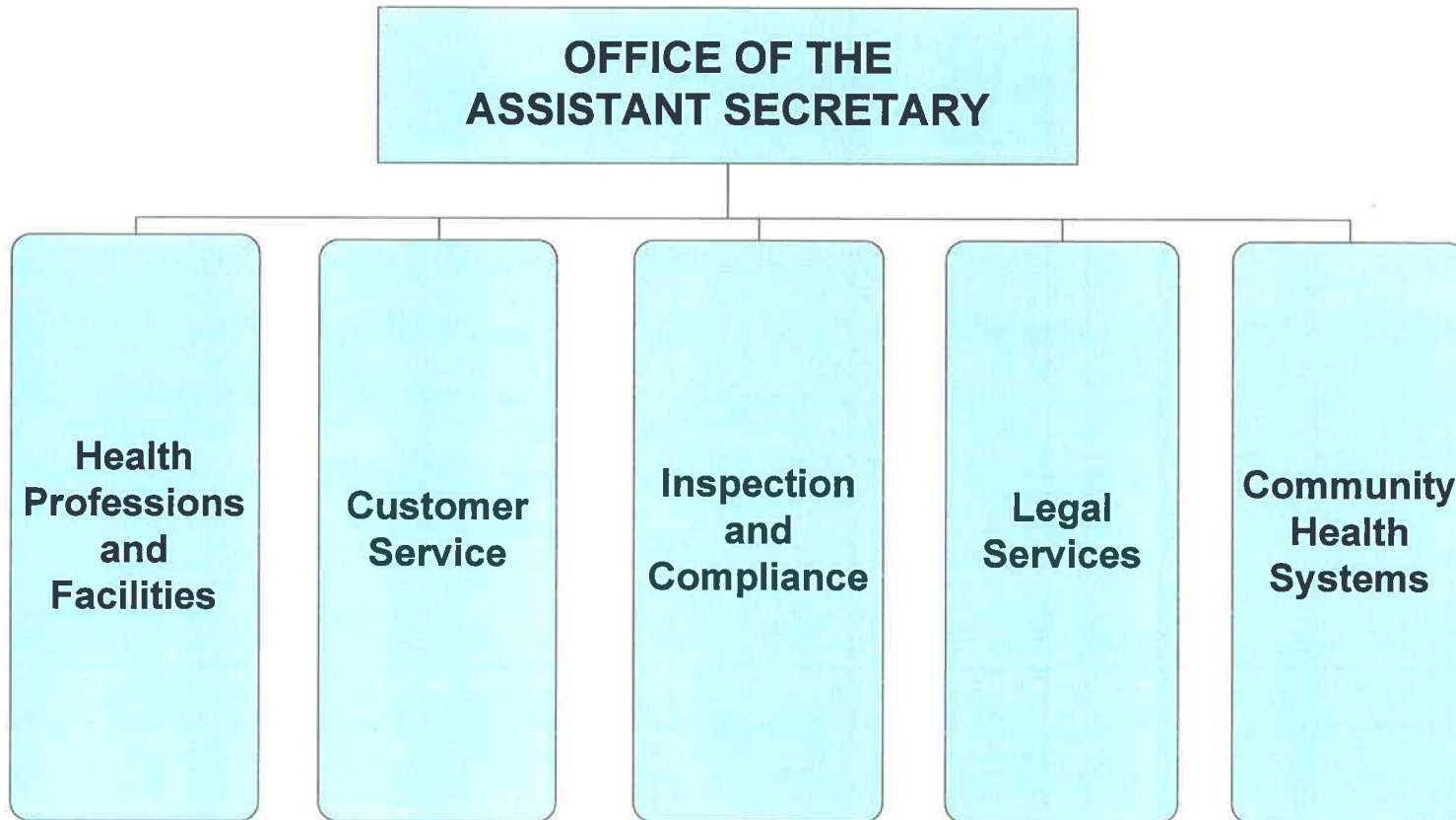


Organizational Review - Realignment (continued)
