AREA OF ACTION	WHAT WASHINGTON CAN DO 2009 – 2014 OBJECTIVES
POLICY	1. Increase funding for suicide prevention programs.
ORGANIZATIONAL PRACTICES	2. Increase the number of local youth-focused groups who adopt programs that address suicide prevention and intervention.
COALITIONS AND NETWORKS	3. Increase the number of local coalitions, task forces, and networks that advance suicide prevention programs.
PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION	4. Increase the community mobilization skills of people who develop local suicide prevention programs.
COMMUNITY EDUCATION	5. Increase the availability of data and other information that local communities can use to show the need for youth suicide prevention programs.
INDIVIDUAL KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS	6. Increase the number of people who know where to join youth suicide prevention efforts in their community.
