Documents you can register include:

- Health Care Directive
- Durable Power of Attorney for Health Care
- Mental Health Advance Directive
- Physician Orders for Life Sustaining Treatment

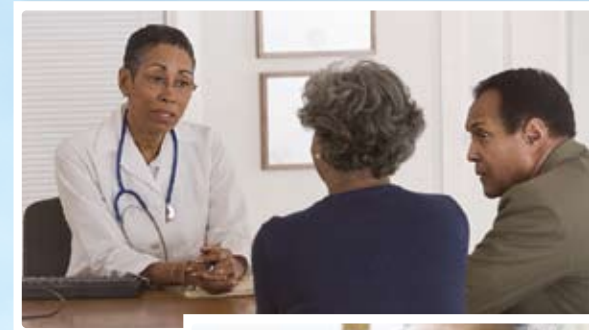
