1	Continue to educate staff and providers about immunization changes and any new vaccines	Attend trainings and share with staff and providers
1	Work with Asotin County School District nurses to encourage vaccination rather than exemptions and encourage use of recommended vaccines	Make every effort to get child scheduled for appointment, if regular schedule does not work for them
1	Continue to train employees and providers for Child Profile entry
