This survey is gathering information for activities and services conducted during 2012 (January 1 through December 31). The 2012 survey is divided into eight parts covering different topic areas. The section that follows has 18 questions and addresses activities and services delivered across Washington's local public health agencies in the area of Environmental Health.

Notes on Taking This Survey

1. After each question is a "NEXT>" button. The survey, however, will not allow you to proceed if it detects an error (such as a required question left blank). If you are returned to the top of the question, a message in **RED** will tell you how to correct the error.
2. You can move back through the survey to change the answer to questions you have already completed by using the "<BACK" button at the bottom of the page. **DO NOT use the back arrow on your web browser as this may disconnect you from the survey.**
3. At the bottom of each page is a Progress Bar which will give you an approximate estimate of how much of the entire survey you have completed.
4. At any time you can leave this survey before completing it by clicking on the "SAVE" button at the bottom of the page. A return authorization will be emailed to you with a link to continue exactly where you left off. Please do not start a new survey or we will then have multiple data entries from your jurisdiction.
