In accordance with WAC 246-310-080, the University of Washington Medical Center (UWMC) hereby submits a letter of intent to add 79 beds to its existing 450 licensed beds. In conformance with the WAC, the following information is provided:

**1. A Description of the Extent of Services Proposed:**

UWMC proposes to add 79 acute care beds to our existing Hospital. Upon project completion, the Hospital will have a total of 529 licensed beds.

**2. Estimated Cost of the Proposed Project:**


The estimated capital expenditure for the new beds is \$70,771,363.00.

**3. Description of the Service Area:**

UWMC is a tertiary teaching hospital, and our service area spans the WAMI region. However, for purposes of acute care bed need planning, UWMC is assigned to the North King Hospital Planning Area. Accordingly the service area for this CN review is North King.
