In 2017, the Holiday Hideaway water system was awarded a Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) loan to address elevated levels of iron and manganese in their drinking water, harden infrastructure against seawater intrusion, better control well withdrawal rates, and increase storage capacity. The project achieved iron and manganese treatment with aeration—a simple process that does not require treatment chemicals or feed systems. Additionally, the project replaced finished water pumps to bolster reliability and efficiency for years to come. The project was financed with a DWSRF loan for:

\$576,739 at 1.5 percent interest rate for 20 years and was completed in the fall of 2021.

Public health and environmental benefits

Holiday Hideaway now provides safe and reliable drinking water that meets state standards. The additional storage makes it a more reliable and resilient system.
