Dear Provider,

If you provide care to young people who are immunocompromised or HIV-positive, they are at greater risk for HPV infection. Men and women who are immunocompromised or HIV-positive, and men who have sex with men (MSM), are also more likely to develop HPV-related cancers if infected with HPV.<sup>1</sup>

As Washington State's Epidemiologist for Communicable Diseases, I am asking you to join me in protecting immunocompromised and HIV-positive patients by routinely recommending and administering HPV immunization. Studies confirm that your recommendation and offer of vaccines are essential to ensuring uptake. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends vaccination of everyone aged 9-26 years not vaccinated previously<sup>2</sup> especially those that are immunocompromised, HIV-positive, and men who have sex with men (MSM).<sup>3</sup> Additionally, adults aged 27-45 years may choose to be vaccinated after talking with their healthcare provider.<sup>2</sup>
