- 2. Students are required to send Official Transcripts for Undergraduate work to Graduate Programs along with the Non-Matriculated Application.
- 3. Prospective students register using the Registration and Override Form. This form will be sent in with the Non-Matriculated Application. - 4. Once courses are completed and grades are posted, students will be emailed a certificate of completion from Addiction Studies.
