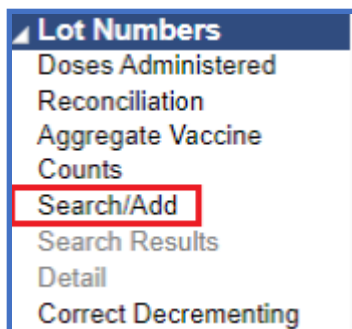
How do I add COVID-19 vaccines into my clinic's IIS Inventory?


How do I manually add COVID-19 vaccine supply into my IIS inventory?

To manage COVID-19 vaccine supply not received through CVP or AVP orders you can manually add them to your clinic's inventory in the IIS. For more information on managing inventory in the IIS click [here](#).

1. Login to your Organization/Facility in the IIS.
2. Click on the **Lot Numbers** heading in the left menu of the IIS. Click **Search/Add** to open the **Lot Number Maintenance** screen.



3. Enter the **Lot Number** you want to add to your inventory.
4. Click **Search**.
5. If the lot number exists in your clinic's inventory, it will appear in the Search Results. If not, click the **Add** button on the bottom right to open the **Lot Number Maintenance [Add]** screen.

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6. Enter the information below to add the vaccine to your inventory.

- a. Select the **Manufacturer**.
- b. Select the **Vaccine**. Reference [this table](#) to determine which product to choose based on the description in the dropdown menu.
- c. Enter the **Expiration Date**.
- d. Enter the **Funding Source**. PRVT should be used for privately purchased vaccines.
- e. Select a **Reason for Change**.
- f. Enter the **Number of Doses**.
- g. Select the **Product**.
- h. Select the **NDC Number**.
**Product must be chosen first to populate the NDC Number.*
- i. Click the **Add** button to add the lot to your clinic's inventory. You will now be able to view this lot number in the **Reconciliation** screen.
