# What is an IIS?

---

## Immunization Information System (IIS)

Secure system that houses immunization records for the population of a certain area (e.g. state)

# What is the Purpose of an IIS?

---

- Collect and share immunization data across authorized healthcare organizations, clinics, pharmacies, schools and other partners in a jurisdiction
- Provide comprehensive immunization records
- Provide clinical decision support tools (e.g. Forecast)
- Assess population-level vaccination coverage and trends
- Facilitate public health response to vaccine preventable disease outbreaks and other public health emergencies

# WAIS

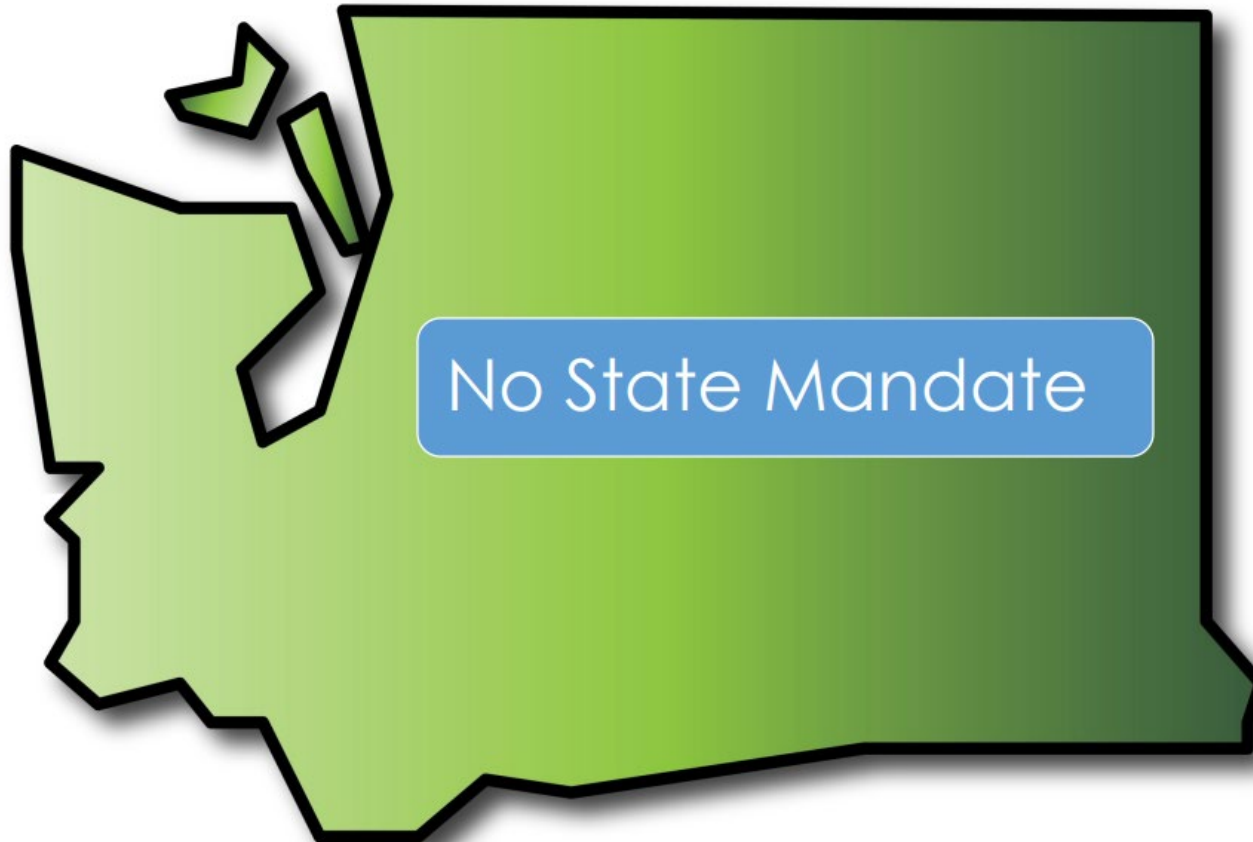
---

- WAIS is short for the **Washington State Immunization Information System**
  - Includes more than **152 million** immunization records for more than **13 million** people
  - Immunization data comes from over **2500** organizations
  - More than **19,000** IIS end users
  - Data collected in the IIS is consolidated into a comprehensive record for a patient over their lifetime

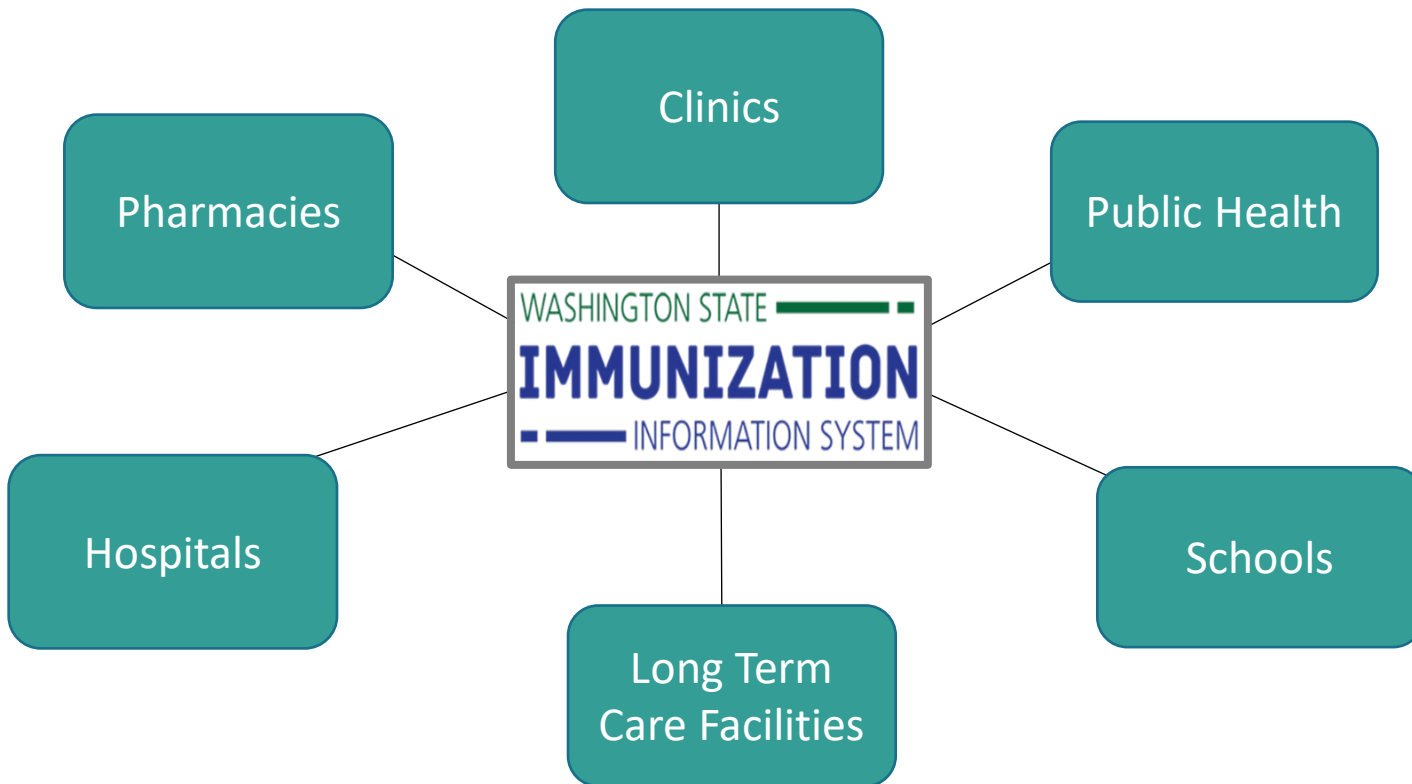

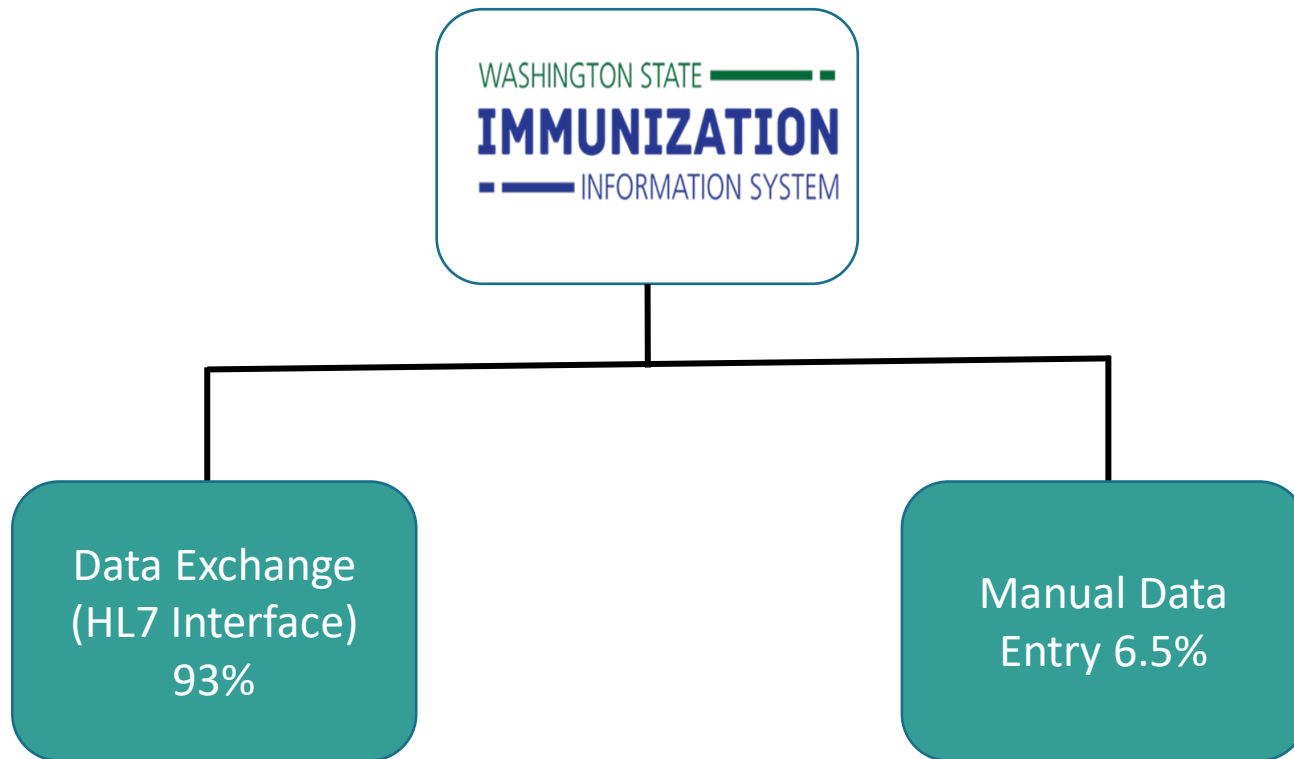

# Benefits of Using an IIS

---

- Easy access to comprehensive immunization records, increasing a provider's ability to make better clinical decisions
- Clinics can order, receive, manage and report inventory for publicly supplied vaccines
- Assess and improve vaccination coverage
- Assess and monitor compliance with school/work immunization requirements
- Assists public health decision making in vaccine preventable disease outbreaks
