



#### **Access Your Family's Immunization Information**

There are a few ways you can access your family's immunization information:

#### Option 1: Sign up for MyIRMobile.com

Sign up for MylRMobile by going to <u>myirmobile.com</u> and follow the registration instructions. Your registration information will be used to match your records with the state immunization registry. You will be sent a verification code on your phone to finalize the process. Once registration is complete, you'll be able to view your immunization records, Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS), and access your COVID-19 vaccination certificate.

# Option 2: Request a Complete Immunization Record from Your Health Care Provider, Clinic, or Local Pharmacy

Most health care providers in Washington use the Washington State Immunization System. Ask your doctor or other primary care person if they can give you a complete immunization record for your child. They can print it from the Immunization Information System or provide records from their medical record system.

### Option 3: Request a Complete Immunization Record from Your Child's School

All public schools and some private schools in Washington have access to the Washington State Immunization Information System. Depending on staffing, schools may be able to print out immunization records for students if requested ahead of time.

## Option 4: Request a Complete Immunization Record from the Department of Health

If you can't get a complete immunization record from your provider and you don't want to sign up for

MyIRMobile, contact the Office of Immunization at WAIISRecords@doh.wa.gov, or call 360-236-3595 or 1-866-397-0337. The Department of Health uses the Washington State Immunization Information System, but it does not have complete immunization records for all people. When you call, you'll be asked to provide identifying information, such as name, date of birth, and address. At that time, we will tell you if a record exists in the system, but no other information will be released over the phone. This is to protect the privacy and confidentiality of your information.
