This is the third biennial report of the Department of Licenses and covers the past two-year period, beginning January 1, 1925, and ending December 31, 1926.

From previous reports a general idea can be obtained of the scope and character of the functions and duties of this department and we do not think it necessary to elaborate this report for that purpose.

During the biennium ending December 31, 1926, the General Division of the Department of Licenses showed more activities and were responsible for the largest sum being turned in to the State Treasury since the Department's organization in 1921. The records of operators' licenses issued during the first seventeen months of the 1925-6 period as compared with those issued during a like period in 1923-4 show a decided increase as follows:

1926	432,616
1925	350,865
Increase	81,751

This large increase is due partly to the increase in motor registrants, but more so to the activities of the Highway Patrol and county and city peace officers.

REAL ESTATE DEPARTMENT

The extraordinary session of the 19th Legislature enacted a law requiring the registration and licensing of all real estate brokers, to take effect April 7, 1926. However, no provision was made for any appropriation of funds to take care of the administration of the provisions of this law, and the department has been greatly handicapped in handling properly the vast amount of work necessary to carry out its complete enforcement. From this source more than \$15,000.00 in application fees has been collected from applicants during its first year of operation, and it is apparent that additions to the office personnel must be made in order that the law may be properly enforced.

During its first year of operation, a total of 3,121 licenses have been issued to real estate brokers. These licentiates are required to pay an annual renewal fee which is due before January 1st of each year. It is probable that there will be more than 5,000 registrants for 1927.
