


## Washington State Immunization Information System Quick Reference Guide



## **HPV Vaccine Forecast**

As of January 20, 2023, the Washington Immunization Information System accommodates the recommendation for the administration of the Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine series starting at age 9.

The <u>Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS)</u> will show HPV vaccines as **'Recommended Vaccines (Not Required)'** for patients ages 9 and older.

The <u>Coverage Rate Report</u> is a useful tool to monitor immunizations rates for your clinic. This report allows you to measure your clinic's HPV immunization rates (# and % of patients who are up to date) and obtain lists of patients who are due for the HPV vaccine.
