How to Search for and Advertise Vaccines for Transfer

The Vaccine Advertisement function allows you to transfer vaccines to and from other providers. This is a simple and easy way to send and receive vaccines when your facility is either in need of or has a surplus of vaccines or immunization products.

How can I find additional vaccine or immunization products?

You can look for clinic advertisements through the **Vaccine Advertisement** screen within the Immunization Information System (IIS). Your facility must have a PIN and you will need the necessary IIS user permissions to access this function.



- 1. Click on **Orders/Transfers** heading in the left menu of the IIS. Then click **Vaccine Advertisement** to open the **Vaccine Advertisement** screen.
- 2. The first page that comes up will default to 'View All Vaccines Advertisements' option.



3. To request advertised vaccines, contact the provider listed and ask them to initiate a vaccine transfer request in the IIS.



How can I advertise immunization products available to transfer?


You can list available immunization products through the **Vaccine Advertisement** screen within the Immunization Information System (IIS). Your facility must have a PIN and you will need the necessary IIS user permissions to access this function.



- 1. Click on **Orders/Transfers** heading in the left menu of the IIS. Then click **Vaccine Advertisement** to open the **Vaccine Advertisement** screen.
- Click the radio button next to Advertise Vaccine for Transfer.



3. Enter the information for the vaccines you would like to advertise and click Advertise.





TIP: All vaccine transfers must be approved by the Washington State Immunization Program before being physically exchanged by providers. You can view the status of your transfer request on the **Create/ViewOrders** screen.

How do I remove or update my vaccine advertisement?

You will need to manually remove your clinic's advertisements.

- 1. Return to the Vaccine Advertisement page in the IIS.
- 2. Click on the radio button next to Advertise Vaccine for Transfer.
- 3. Scroll down to the vaccine that was advertised and click either the Update or Delete button on the right side of the listing.
 - a. If you need to adjust the amount of vaccine advertised click Update.
 - b. If you need to delete the advertisement due to transfer or vaccine expiration, click Delete.
- 4. Please make sure to reconcile your inventory. Follow the instructions for <u>How to Search, Add,</u> Reconcile and Report Inventory.
