Temporary Practice Permit Effective Dates for Licensed Practical Nurses (LPN) and Registered Nurses (RN). The Washington State Board of Nursing (board) adopted amendments to WAC 246-840-095, reducing the length of time a temporary practice permit is effective and updating criteria to issue a temporary practice permit in order to align the internal board process with rule language and implement Second Substitute House Bill (2SHB) 1009 (chapter 165, Laws of 2023). **Filed as WSR 24-03-055**.
