Greetings Honorable Tribal Leaders and Tribal Partners:

SUBJECT: Informational- Potential agency request legislation for water recreation facilities

In accordance with chapter <u>43.376 RCW</u>, the <u>Washington State Centennial Accord of 1989</u>, and <u>DOH</u> <u>Consultation and Collaboration Procedure</u>, I am writing today to provide information about potential 2025 agency request legislation to amend <u>chapter 70.90 RCW</u>, which regulates water recreation facilities, such as swimming pools, water parks, and natural areas used for swimming.

The department is proposing to amend chapter 70.90 RCW to achieve the following:

- Conform state law with the federal Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)'s <u>Model Aquatic</u> Health Code (MAHC) standards;
- Align the terms used with terms used in the CDC's Model Aquatic Health Code;
- Expand "designated swim areas" to include those natural areas posted for swimming;
- Require insurance for all aquatic facilities; and
- Remove the exemption for therapy pools.
