Greetings Honorable Tribal Leaders, Partners & Professionals:

In alignment with chapter <u>43.376 RCW</u>, the <u>Washington State Centennial Accord of 1989</u>, and the <u>DOH Consultation and Collaboration Procedure</u>, we invite collaboration on the following topics related to Foundational Public Health Services (FPHS): Unspent funds proposal from the Vape Tax account; Unspent 2023-2025 funds; contracting; and 2025 priorities.

In 2019, the Washington State legislature established the Governmental Public Health System in Washington State to include Sovereign Tribes and Indian Health Programs. This enables FPHS funding to be allocated to federally recognized Tribes and Indian Health Programs as part of the governmental public health system RCW 43.70.512.
