## SAFE HAVEN LAW in Washington State



Parents in Washington who are unable to care for their newborn may anonymously transfer their unharmed baby within 72 hours of birth to a qualified person at a designated drop-off location. No criminal charges will be filed for surrendering a baby under this law. Parents do not have to provide any identifying information.

## **Designated drop-off locations**

Parents can transfer their unharmed newborns with an on-duty staff member at one of the following locations during open hours:

- Any hospital in Washington Emergency departments are open 24/7 and are the safest drop-off option.
- 2. **A staffed fire station** When the station is open.
- 3. A staffed rural health clinic When the clinic is open.

No questions will be asked, and no identifying information is required.
