At A Glance

Fund Balance: \$(831,000)

Increased \$75,000

Renewals: 10,254 (+3%)

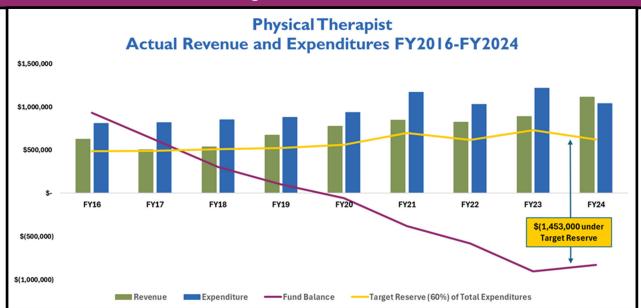
Expenditures: \$1,037,000

Significant Highlights

- Revenue increased due to the June 2023 fee increase.
- Overall costs decreased 20% primarily due to a decline in HELMS obligations, decreased time allocated by staff, and one-time funding to support credentialing backlogs.
- In 2024, the program implemented SSHB1039 legislation which allowed intramuscular needling with an endorsement.

 69%

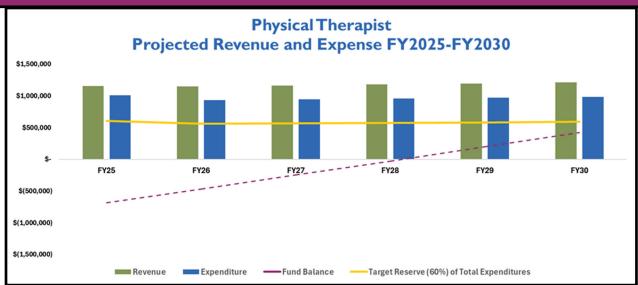
Cost Projections

- Average annual cost: \$963,000
- Expense growth rate FY2025: -3%
- Subsequent growth: < 1% annually, driven by inflation, personnel-related expenses, and disciplinary costs

Fee Activity Projections

- The department increased fees in FY2023 to correct the fund deficit and reach target reserve. Compact fees were not increased.
- The fund is projected to meet the target reserve in FY2031.
 Compact fees are expected to increase within 1-2 years to match current license fees.
