This report is based on the location of the WIC clinic where participants were seen and where the WIC benefits were issued. Only WIC clinics open during FFY24 are included. (Incomplete and/or missing data are excluded.) **TOTAL PARTICIPANTS** is the number of women, infants, and children participating in WIC during FFY24. The total number statewide will be less than the sum across districts because participants who visit clinics in more than one district are only counted once in the statewide totals. **FOOD DOLLARS REDEEMED** is all food purchased by WIC participants during FFY24 except from the WIC Farmers Market Nutrition Program (FMNP) which is a separate grant. **FRUITS & VEGETABLES** dollars are a subset of total food dollars redeemed.
