Enclosed is Certificate of Need Certificate of Need #1417 issued to PeaceHealth approving the reconfiguration and relocation of beds and services between St. Joseph Hospital's south campus and main campus.

The certificate is not approval for any other local, federal, or state statutes, rules, or regulations. Such a project may also need Department of Health approval for a construction plan and facility licensing or certification, as well as other federal or local jurisdiction permits.

The Certificate of Need is valid for two years during which time you must start the project. If there is substantial and continuing progress, we may extend the certificate for one six month period. For an extension, you must submit an extension request at least 120 days before the expiration. You cannot begin a project after the expiration date.

We monitor projects until completed or the expiration date, whichever occurs last. We do this with quarterly progress reports. At least 30 days before the report's due date, you will receive a form to complete and return. Description/Services To Be Provided:

This certificate approves two related projects:

1) the relocation of 20 psychiatric beds from St. Joseph Hospital's south campus to its main campus thereby relocating all psychiatric services to the main campus.

2) the redistribution of 10 dedicated psychiatric beds from St. Joseph Hospital's south campus to its main campus. The 10 dedicated psychiatric beds will be used as general medical surgical care.

Condition

St. Joseph Hospital is licensed for 253 acute care beds located on two campuses. This approval does not change the total number of licensed beds for St. Joseph Hospital.
