Dear Mr. Lopardo:

The Department of Health has completed its review of your application to amend Replacement Authorization (RA) #067E. As you know RA #067 was issued on August 3, 2009, approving the replacement of Avamere Highlands Memory Care and Rehabilitation in Tacoma, within Pierce County, to a new site in DuPont, also within Pierce County. RA #067E was issued on April 21, 2011, extending the validity of RA #067 from August 3, 2011, to February 3, 2012. RA #067EA issued today approves the replacement at a new site in Pierce County.

The RA is not approval for any other local, federal, or state statutes, rules, or regulations. Such a project may also need Department of Health approval for a construction plan and facility licensing or certification, as well as other federal or local jurisdiction permits.

This decision may be appealed. The two appeal options are listed below.

Appeal Option 1:

You or any interested or affected person may request a public hearing to reconsider this decision. The request must state the specific reasons for reconsideration in accordance with Washington Administrative Code 246-310-560. Appeal Option 2:

You or any affected person with standing may request an adjudicative proceeding to contest this decision within 28 calendar days from the date of this letter. The notice of appeal must be filed according to the provisions of Revised Code of Washington 34.05 and Washington Administrative Code 246-310-610. Description of Approved Project

Highlands Rehab, LLC is the existing licensee of Avamere Highlands Memory Care and Rehabilitation located in Tacoma, within Pierce County. Avamere Highlands Properties, LLC (Realco) is the building owner of Avamere Highlands Memory Care and Rehabilitation. Currently Avamere Highlands Memory Care and Rehabilitation is licensed for 86 skilled nursing beds and has zero beds banked under the alternate use section of Revised Code of Washington 70.38.111(8) and Washington Administrative Code 246-310-395.

This Amended Replacement Authorization approves the replacement of 48 of 86 nursing home beds from Avamere Highlands Memory Care and Rehabilitation to a new site in DuPont, within Pierce County. The name of the new facility is unknown as of the issuance of this Replacement Authorization. Avamere Highlands Properties, LLC (Realco) provided documentation demonstrating approval of the replacement of Avamere Highlands Memory Care and Rehabilitation from Tacoma to DuPont. At project completion, the maximum number of beds at the new facility will be 48. Highlands Rehab, LLC has relinquished the remaining 38 beds.

This Extended and Amended Replacement Authorization is effective from <u>August 3, 2011</u>, through <u>February 3, 2012</u>, unless withdrawn, suspended, or revoked in accordance with applicable sections of the Certificate of Need law and regulations.
