The Chiropractic Quality Assurance Commission (commission) will not enforce AIDS training, education, and documentation requirements in WAC <u>246-808-105(2)(g)</u> and chapter <u>246-12</u> WAC, Part 8. These rules are being repealed to comply with Engrossed Substitute House Bill (ESHB) <u>1551</u> enacted in law by the Washington State Legislature in 2020.

ESHB <u>1551</u> repeals statutes concerning AIDS education and training for emergency medical personnel, health professionals (including chiropractors), and health care facility employees intended to reduce the stigma towards people living with HIV/AIDS by not isolating AIDS as an exceptional disease that requires specific training and education separate from other conditions.

Effective June 11, 2020, RCW 70.24.270 (Health professionals—Rules for AIDS education and training) was repealed as a result of ESHB 1551. As a result of this law being repealed, the Department of Health will repeal chapter 246-12 WAC, Part 8, and the commission will repeal WAC 246-808-105(2)(g) and parts of WAC 246-808-010 in support of ESHB 1551 and to support people living with HIV/AIDS.

During the process of repealing rules, the requirements in chapter $\underline{246-12}$ WAC, Part 8 and WAC $\underline{246-808-105(2)(g)}$ that are applicable to chiropractors will not be enforced by the commission.
