Compliance Rates For Consumer Confidence Reports That Were Due July 1, 2017

The Consumer Confidence Report regulation is a federal and state requirement. The Washington State Department of Health Office of Drinking Water (ODW) has reporting obligations to the federal Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and gives EPA the names of systems that did not submit a report to ODW by July 1, 2017.

The following is a summary of the compliance rates for data reporting year 2016 reports that were due to system customers and DOH by July 1, 2017 (data as of December 31, 2016). These statistics reflect compliance rates for the distribution of the report only. The names of systems that did not submit a report to the state are listed under Non-compliant systems.
