RE: Department of Health 2022 Supplemental Operating Budget Submittal

Dear David:

I respectfully submit the Department of Health's 2022 supplemental operating budget requests for Governor Inslee's consideration.

The COVID-19 pandemic response and recovery remain the Department's top priorities; however, it is still important for the state to maintain and build a resilient public health system that protects our citizens and prepares us for the future. This budget request includes the necessary funding to continue supporting the ongoing statewide effort to control the spread of COVID-19, looking to American Rescue Plan Act resources provided to Washington State by the federal government specifically for these purposes.

It places significant focus on behavioral health and equity, two areas of need prior to the pandemic but exacerbated by its disparate impacts on our communities, particularly our youth. And our proposal looks to the future by positioning the state to better address and respond to the next wave of health challenges, including modernizing data systems and addressing health impacts from climate change.

While the department's budget submittal includes the highest priority and most urgent public health needs, there are still outstanding challenges and equally important priorities not included in this request that need to be addressed immediately. The state needs to identify a long-term solution to isolate and quarantine individuals who have been exposed or tested positive for a communicable disease. There are also lab capacity needs that align with the provisions of the American Rescue Plan Act.

My team will continue to work with your staff to identify the most effective solutions to address these needs for consideration in the Governor's proposed supplemental budget to the legislature. These requests are a priority as well for our public health system to be effective in protecting the health of our people.
